### The North Yorkshire & York Healthy Schools Programme

The North Yorkshire& York Healthy Schools Programme goes from strength to strength each academic year. 77% of schools in North Yorkshire have registered with the programme and 117 schools have achieved an award. We welcome York schools some of whom started the award at the end of the summer term. The Programme is free for all maintained and academy schools in North Yorkshire & York

Recent evaluation of the programme with schools showed:

- 98% of schools were either very satisfied or satisfied with the Healthy Schools Programme
- 99% of schools were either very satisfied or satisfied with the support provided by the Healthy Schools team
- Comments on the programme were largely positive. Schools said it was a great and
  enjoyable scheme, and they welcomed the support from the team. They liked to be
  able to review and improve current practice and achieve recognition for their work.
