### **The North Yorkshire & York Healthy Schools Programme**

The North Yorkshire & York Healthy Schools Programme goes from strength to strength each academic year. 80% of schools in North Yorkshire have registered with the programme and 159 schools have achieved an award.. **The Programme is free for all maintained and academy schools in North Yorkshire & York**

The Healthy Schools Programme enables school to audit and evidence their practice against best practice to improve the health and wellbeing of the whole school community across four key themes alongside staff wellbeing. Schools can work on the themes in any order and is an excellent way to showcase the good practice the school is delivering to support the Personal Development provision.

- Active Lives
- Food in Schools
- PSHE
- Emotional Health and Wellbeing

Schools work towards Bronze; one theme, Silver; two themes plus staff wellbeing and Gold being the final two themes.
