KS2 Session

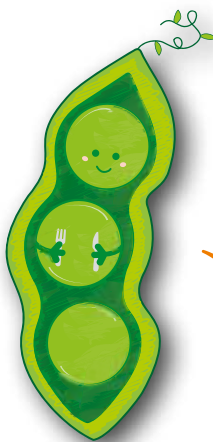
The Fun Filled Food Journey
